

SALE OF CHAMETZ

During Pesach, we traditionally do not own any chametz. To avoid throwing or giving away the chametz we may have in our possession, we sell it to a non-Jewish person for the duration of the festival. Often, people will authorize a person within the community to sell the chametz on their behalf.

Since Rabbi Rachel will be on Sabbatical, this Pesach she will procure an authority for us. Passover begins on April 1, 2026; therefore, I must receive this form by March 25th in order to prepare for the sale of the chametz. Please fill in the form below and return it to me.

DECLARATION

I, the undersigned, fully empower and permit Rabbi Rachel Schoenfeld to act on my behalf to sell all chametz, knowingly or unknowingly in my possession in places that I own or lease, as denied in the Torah and Rabbinic Law. Furthermore, this includes chametz that tends to harden and adhere to the inside of surfaces of pans, pots, cooking and useable utensils, automobiles, and all kinds of live animals that eat chametz or a mixture thereof.
